a) <u>Planning Applications</u>

23/00161/HOUSE Oakview Heath Lane Henwick- Installation of an aluminium Pergola (2.9m Wide x 2.75m Deep and 2.4m high) attached to the eastern wall of existing dwelling and on top of existing 30cm high decking. Total height from ground level will be 2.7m High.NOTE - Existing rear boundary height is 2.4M high from previous planning application (Ref: 22/02634/HOUSE) and the boundary has landscaped bushes/trees that will make the impact on neighbouring amenity minimal or no impact whatsoever. No Objection - Unanimous
